School 12 Uniforms



The policy, which was approved by the School-Based Planning Team on April 16, 2012 and will take effect with the 2012 – 2013 school year, states:

Tops:

Students will wear sold-color tops in light blue, navy, purple or white. Options include:

- Polo shirts
- T-shirts
- No designs, writing or logos are allowed
- Sweatshirts **without** hoods
- Cardigan sweaters, crew neck sweaters and vests may be worn
- Any type of School 12 logo attire (including hooded sweatshirts) is allowed
- During cold weather, any solid-color long-sleeve shirt may be worn under uniform shirt

Bottoms:

Students will wear navy, black or khaki bottoms. Options include:

- Pants (NO JEANS)
- Sweatpants
- Capris
- Shorts and skirts (fingertip rule applies)
- Jumpers
- Leggings under skirts or shorts (may not be worn with just a top)

- **No labels, designs, letters or numbers on any clothing**
- **Pants must fit properly at the waist. Tops must fit properly (not too big or too small)**
- **No exposed layering under shirts, except for turtlenecks and long sleeves in winter**
- ** No open back sandals/shoes, flip-flop sandals, Adidas/Jordan slides

What is the next step?

The School-Based Planning Team will be meeting with the Building Committee to discuss implementation and enforcement. Information will continue to be sent home as the implementation process unfolds.
